**Pray:** Light a candle. Open your devotion with prayer.

God of wisdom, you are speaking even when we are not listening. Incline our ears to hear what you are telling us, in this day, in this world, for the life of your people. In Jesus' name, amen.



**Read:** Read the key verses from Sunday's reading.

*Long ago God spoke to our ancestors in many and various ways by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, through whom he also created the worlds. (Hebrews 1:1-2)*



**Reflect:** Reflect on the scripture summary.

Agnes ago, God spoke through prophets, but the people ceased to listen. Eventually, God sent Jesus to speak God's word to us. We are blessed that we can still hear God's voice through the words of Jesus.



**Connect:** Connect in conversation with others in your household.
