Thank You For Serving

"I told them that the hand of my God had been gracious upon me, and also the words that the king had spoken to me. Then they said, "Let us start building!" So they committed themselves to the common good. (Nehemiah 2:18)

For the past few months, the Session and Trustees have used the book of Nehemiah for our devotions. Nehemiah is a book in the Old Testament that tells the story of a person God used to rebuild the wall around Jerusalem. Nehemiah was one of the Israelites who had been forced into exile. While the Jews were under exile in Babylon, Nehemiah worked as the cupbearer to the Persian king Artexerxes. God's hand is evident in the events as Nehemiah is able to get the king to allow him to return to Jerusalem, and as the king even arranges for Nehemiah to get the materials and permission he needs to do the rebuilding project.

Once he arrived in Jerusalem, Nehemiah began by privately going out at night to inspect the walls. He then shared his plan with the Jews around him. In chapter three, we see that they set to work on rebuilding with a detailed organizational plan. The priests rebuilt and consecrated the Sheep Gate. People from Jericho and different parts of Jerusalem divided up the sections of the wall among them and repaired, rebuilt, and built each part of the wall. The author also points out that the nobles of Tekoite would not put their shoulders to the work of the Lord.

The work to rebuild the wall of Jerusalem was organized much like the work in our churches today. Then the priests had a special duty to consecrate certain things, much like the special role for pastors now. Then the people divided the work according to their location and abilities. We do the same now. Like now, they had a few people who didn't help at all.

As we studied the third chapter of Nehemiah we asked ourselves what God might show us through the text. We saw that it is important to understand that each person must serve according to their abilities, proximity to the work, and their role. We recognized that God will accomplish the mission through the people, sometimes in surprising ways.

I appreciate the gifts and talents of each of you. It is pleasing to God when we each contribute to the ministry in our unique ways. Whether you serve by planting flowers, counting money, teaching a class, painting a bench, or praying, you are a vital part of God's ministry at Condit Presbyterian Church. Thank you for serving!

Odds Are Good Someone You Know Will Need Blood

Give Blood at Condit August 13
Pay it Forward and Save Lives

DID YOU KNOW:

1. Blood cannot be manufactured. It is only obtained through blood donors.
2. Blood shelf life is very short.
 - Whole blood has a life of 21 days from collection.
 - Red cells have a life of 42 days from collection.
 - Platelets have a life of 5 days from collection.
 - Plasma has a life of 1 year from collection.
3. Blood usage is impressive. Think of the number of donors required in the following scenarios, knowing blood donors typically provide 1 unit of blood at each donation.
 - Automobile accident can use between 4 to 100 units of blood.
 - Leukemia patients need 2 to 6 units of red blood cells and 6 to 8 units of platelets daily for 2 to 4 weeks
